5. Summarize the following biblical support for the doctrine of the Trinity: **Genesis 1:26; Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19; John 10:30; 14:16; Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 12:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:19; Ephesians 1:3-14; Philippians 2:6; James 2:19**

6. What reflections of the Trinity can be found in the created order?

7. Respond to this statement: "The doctrine of the Trinity is a good example of the importance of, and need for, theology."
